Overview: The NEW Rnet consortium of the NSF EPSCoR jurisdictions of Delaware (DE), Rhode Island (RI), and Vermont (VT) will create an advanced sensor network in watersheds for gathering high-frequency, spatially-extensive water quality and quantity data and a network of laboratories, field-based experiments, and agent-based models to investigate how to align sensor data and its visualization with utilization by stakeholders and decision makers.
